How to reach Monaco ?

BY PLANE

The closest airport is Nice Côte d'Azur, France. The nearest railway station to Nice Airport is **Nice Saint-Augustin**, located a 10-15 minutes, walk from Terminal 1. Regional trains pass through this station and serve Monaco's train station. The tramway Route 2 – Port Lympia stops at the airport (Terminal 1 & 2) and connects the city center of Nice via "Jean Médecin" station and with the port via the "Port Lympia station". There is a tram to the airport roughly every 8 minutes during the week.

BY TRAIN

BY TAXIS

From Nice Airport to Monaco: at the Terminal 2, the taxi rank is located at entrance A3.

How to get to the Symposium?

The symposium is being held at the **Oceanographic Museum of Monaco** situated Avenue Saint-Martin, 98000 Monaco

Bus transfers are arranged from the Novotel Monte-Carlo, 16 Bd Princesse Charlotte, 98000 Monaco, and the Oceanographic Museum of Monaco. The schedule of the transfers are:

- For the mornings of the 22nd and 23rd, two buses will be stationed at the entrance of the **Novotel Monte-Carlo for departure at 8:20 and 8:30.**
- On the evening of the 22nd, buses will depart from the Oceanographic Museum to the Novotel Monte-Carlo between **19:00 and 21:00.**
- Following the conclusion of the symposium on the 23rd, buses will be available from the Oceanographic Museum to the Novotel Monte-Carlo, operating between **17:15 and 18:15.**

BY CAR

The nearest car park is the Parking du [chemin des pêcheurs](#).

BY BUS

You can take public transport by using line 1 or 2 of the bus network. We invite you to get off at the terminus of the line "Monaco Ville (Le Rocher)" which will drop you off next to the Oceanographic Museum of Monaco, on the Place de la Visitation. The fare for a single trip is 2€ and can be purchased on board.

BY PUBLIC ELECTRIC BIKES

To rent a bike for the first time, download the PBSC mobile application, choose the single trip option and the number of bikes you wish to rent. You will then be directed to the account creation form. The price for a single journey is 1€ for 30 minutes, a deposit of 300€ will be required. For more information: [Carte - MonaBike](#).

BY WALK

The Oceanographic Museum is located at 1.8km from the train station (23 minutes walk away) and at 2km from the Novotel (25 minutes walk away).

Currency exchange

Interchange located at Nice Airport (Terminal 2, level 0, towards the gate A03) offers currency exchanges, VAT refund, tax refund and Western Union money transfer services. Opened from 09.00 to 19.00
